# **Custom Workshops 2025-2026**

### **Option 1. SPARK CURIOSITY: Ensemble**

Spark curiosity in an ensemble-building workshop that will nurture community, build empathy, and strengthen your artistic ensemble. Explore Lookingglass techniques, games, and activities. Gain foundational skills in "Yes, And..." thinking, collaboration, and improvisation.

### **Option 2. IGNITE CREATIVITY: Devise**

Ignite creativity in a workshop where participants build their own original stories and performances. Participants will take inspiration from life, art, and each other while learning Lookingglass techniques for making your very own "world premiere." Already got an idea? Bring your own story-starter and let Lookingglass help you turn that idea into performance. Need an idea? Let's ignite your creativity!

### **Option 3. ACTIVATE STORYTELLING: Physical Storytelling**

Activate storytelling in a workshop that will introduce participants to an actor's toolkit! Increase body awareness and confidence, learn how your body can build character and tell a story, and choose one focus area for exploration: ensemble movement, puppetry, clowning, or mask. This workshop is fully accessible – all are welcome and no prior experience in theatre movement is needed.

**Booking Information:** Lookingglass workshops range from one 2-hour session to multiple sessions over a series of weeks and are priced accordingly. Onsite, offsite, and virtual workshops are available. The workshops above may be further customized to best support the needs and interests of your group.
